# How can we prepare our child for school? Teach/encourage them to:

- talk about school and the adults they will see
- encourage communication skills; asking questions and listening to the answer, sharing and taking turns.
- Manners and behaviour
- use the toilet properly and wash hands
- look after their things and tidy up
- know how to use a knife and fork
- dress and undress (putting clothes on the right way)
- get ready for learning to read by sharing and enjoying books, play listening and rhyming game, reading is about what you hear just as much as what you see. b-e-d
- recognise their name and attempt to write it
- develop early number sense it's much more than being able to count
- gross and fine motor skill development activities
