Attendance

Attendance at Our Lady and St Edward's is usually good and continues to be monitored. A small number of children have attendance which is below 90% and as such are considered to be persistent absentees (PA). Currently, our PA is 5.6% which relates to 12 pupils (Y1-6). Compared to this time last year our PA was 10.5%, this is a huge improvement-many thanks to those families who have supported this improvement. It is important that children attend school regularly so that there is continuity of learning and consistent social interactions with their peers. We appreciate that illness cannot be avoided but would encourage that parents carefully consider if their child is still well enough to attend school even though they are slightly under the weather. Please check your child's attendance via arbor.

Medication in School

A reminder to parents that if your child requires **prescribed** medication in school that we only accept this medication if it is in date, labelled, provided in the original container as dispensed by a pharmacist and includes instructions for administration, dosage and storage. We will not be able to administer any other medication.

Before medication can be given parents/guardians will need to complete a Parental Agreement for Our Lady and St Edward's School to administer medicine form available from the school office.
