  - Using commas in a list
  - Identify verbs, adjectives, adverbs and expanded noun phrases
  - Using different forms of punctuation.
  - Verb tenses

We will continue to have a big push on the basic four operations; addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will complete units of work on fractions, time, statistics and position and direction. Remember to practise telling the time regularly. We will revise our previous learning and look at how to apply what we know to reasoning questions.

<u>Computing</u> We will continue to use technology to support all areas of our learning. We will develop our understanding of digital photography. We will learn how to use and create a branching data base.

## Topic Work

photographs as a source of evidence as well as interviewing elderly friends or relatives. In Geography, we will be identifying natural and man-made features of our local coast. We are very excited to have another trip organised to visit Fylde Sand Dunes Beach School. Wellies will be needed for this trip.

In Science, we will be thinking about the habitats and animals we observed during our trip to Leighton Moss and we will discover what a plant needs to grow well. We will then investigate the properties of materials of things you might take to the seaside. We will also be carrying out fair test investigations.

## D&T

In our D&T lessons, we will be designing and making our own moving vehicle for transporting equipment to the beach.

## <u>Art</u>

We will be developing our painting skills by creating landscapes linked to the seaside. We will be using the beach hut paintings by Lynette Amelie as inspiration for creating our own designs.
